

## Catholic Family Center's Women's Residential Programs Liberty Manor and Hannick Hall

Liberty Manor and Hannick Hall are long-term intensive residential drug and alcohol treatment programs for women and children.

Women that successfully complete treatment typically do so in 7-9 months.

Liberty Manor has 17 adult beds and 3 children beds.

Hannick Hall has 20 adult beds and 7 children beds.

### Liberty Manor and Hannick Hall offer:

- Individual and group therapy
- Parenting classes
- Anger Management
- Child reunification
- Relapse prevention
- Life Skills education
- Independent skills readiness
- Leisure education
- Recreational activities
- Addiction Education
- Vocational Education (women may participate in GED classes)
- Health assessments
- Off site daycare connections
- Community sober support
- Mental Health support
- Transportation
- Medication monitoring
- Case management
- Cultural Competency
- Ongoing prenatal support and linkages

### Referrals made to either program must include:

- Recent Psych-social (current within 6 months)
- Mental Health information
- Recent History and Physical (including most recent physical, labs, TB results)
- Discharge Plan/Summary (if available)

Referrals should then be sent to the Intake Coordinator, Emily Price via fax at (585) 266-0214. We request that same information be faxed to our Program Manager Nancy Crowley via fax at (315) 331-2301. This information is reviewed and if your client appears to be appropriate for this level of care either a face-to-face interview or phone interview will be scheduled.

Funding:

- Client's involved with DHS/Public Assistance must have an active PA and Medicaid case
- Client's going to Hannick Hall must have straight Medicaid (no attached plans or options)
- Client's with SSI/SSD benefits must submit income verification
- Other methods of payment require income verification.

Upon admission:

- Client's will be expected to admit with 30 days worth of meds (preferably) or new scripts with active Medicaid
- Proper identification for themselves (as well as their child, if applicable)
