

# Early Intervention Health Homes

At Catholic Family Center

*Being enrolled in an Early Intervention Health Home you will receive:*

- One Care Manager whom manages your EI services (as your service coordinator would) and makes sure you have all of the services you need (doctor appointments, transportation, access to community resources, etc.)
- You will meet face to face with your Care Manager at least one time monthly
- You and your care manager will develop a plan of care unique to you and your family. This will be used to guide services.

If a child is enrolled in EI HH the child and family will be receiving the necessary services through early intervention, and they would be able to utilize the health homes six core services:

1. **Comprehensive Care Management-** a comprehensive health assessment that identifies medical, mental health, and social service needs is developed.
2. **Care Coordination and Health Promotion-** coordinating and arranging for the provision of services, supporting adherence to treatment recommendations, referrals to social and community services, monitoring and evaluating client's needs including prevention, wellness, medical, specialist, and behavioral health treatment. Creating an individual plan of care.
3. **Compressive Transitional Care-** the Health Home provider has a system in place with hospitals and residential/rehabilitation facilities in their network to provide Health Home prompt notification of an individual's admission and/or discharge to/from an emergency room, inpatient, or residential/rehabilitation setting.
4. **Patient and Family Support-** the client's individualized plan of care reflects patient and family or caregiver preferences and support for self-management and other resources as appropriate.
5. **Referral to Community Supports-** the Health Home provider identifies available community based resources and actively manages appropriate referrals, access, engagement, follow-up, and coordination of services.
6. **Use of Health Information Technology (HIT) to Link Services-** Health Home providers will make use of available HIT and access data through the regional health information organization



**As a participant in EI Health Homes we ask that you:**

- Keep all appointments made with your care manager, if you need to cancel or reschedule please contact your care manager in advance
- Have open communication with your care manager
- Meet at least one time monthly in person with your care manager
